

Policy Statement

The Diocese values and encourages the participation of children and young people in parish liturgies and in activities that enhance their spiritual, physical, emotional and social development. The Diocese recognises the dignity and rights of all children and is committed to their protection and support.

The Diocese undertakes to do all in its power to create a safe environment for children and young people and to ensure their protection from neglect, physical, sexual and emotional abuse.

The Diocese is committed to:

1. Creating **SAFE ENVIRONMENTS** for children and young people to participate in Church activities
2. **MINIMISING RISKS**, in order to safeguard the interests of children and young people
3. **Ensuring** that paid employees and volunteer workers are carefully recruited, selected, trained, supported and supervised.
4. **SUPPORTING** victims of abuse.
5. Ensuring that the offenders are held **ACCOUNTABLE** for their actions
6. **REPORTING** all complaints and allegations of abuse to the civil authorities without delay.
